







The brief was to create a trail from the local primary school to Mayesbrook Park in Dagenham to encourage youngsters to visit and experience the abundance of wildlife within the inner city park. Various organisations were involved in the restoration project for the fenced in Brook to be exposed and a natural area created for visitors to enjoy. Looking at the existing insects, birds and fish that are natives of the Brook, images were overlaid and designs created to be etched into the stainless steel discs. The round shape was chosen to represent the bubbles made by the creatures in the brook and within the designs a secret message is contained which can only be spelt out when all the letters are collected. The artwork is also functional and can be used to create rubbings of the images.
